

## PRIVACY POLICY

Rayleigh Solar Tech Inc. (“**Rayleigh**”, “**we**”, “**us**”, “**our**”) has created this Privacy Policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) to set out how we collect, use, and disclose information about identifiable individuals and information which can be used to identify an individual (“**Personal Information**”) about users of our website located at [rayleighsolartech.com](https://rayleighsolartech.com) and related subpages (collectively, “**Website**”) and Personal Information we collect and process in the provision of our products or services (“**Services**”).

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time at our sole discretion. We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy each time you use the Services or Website to see if the Privacy Policy has been changed, as indicated by the “Last Updated” date set out above. We may require you to provide consent to the updated Privacy Policy before further use of the Website or receipt of Services is permitted.

1. **Consent.** By using the Services or Website, you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your Personal Information as described in this Privacy Policy. Except as set forth in this Privacy Policy, your Personal Information will not be collected, stored, used, or disclosed for any other purpose without your consent. We will not actively collect Personal Information for the purpose of sale or marketing of such Personal Information in a way that specifically identifies an individual. You may withdraw your consent to our processing of your Personal Information at any time. However, withdrawing consent may result in your inability to continue using all or part of the Services or Website.
2. **Scope.** This Privacy Policy covers the collection and processing of Personal Information by Rayleigh but does not apply to the collection and processing of Personal Information by third parties that we do not own or control, including Third-Party Integrations (defined below), our customers and third parties that may resell the Services and any services offered by third parties or other sites linked from our Website.
3. **Personal Information You Provide to Us.** We may collect Personal Information you disclose to us as follows:
  - a. **Contacting us via the Website.** Certain functionality of the Website may enable you to contact us, in which case we collect any Personal Information you may choose to provide to us via the Website. We ask that you do not disclose any sensitive Personal Information when you contact us.
  - b. **Receiving and providing goods or services.** We may collect business contact information of individuals who work for our suppliers or customers to communicate with those suppliers or customers about their business relationship with us. We may

also collect payment credentials or related information from our suppliers or customers for generating invoices and payment processing.

- c. **Third-Party Integrations.** We may integrate with or rely on third-party platforms and services to provide some Services to you or to communicate with you ("**Third-Party Integrations**"). For example, you may contact us via LinkedIn, one of our Third-Party Integrations. Any Personal Information submitted to us via Third-Party Integrations that we can access will be subject to this Privacy Policy, but please note that such Personal Information will also be subject to the terms of the applicable Third-Party Integration.
- d. **Applying to Work with Us.** If you would like to work with us and submit hiring materials to us (either directly or through a Third-Party Service or recruiter), we collect any Personal Information in your hiring materials, such as your resume, cover letter, transcripts, or certifications. If you submit hiring materials to us, we ask you to only include information relevant to your job application. Please note that any Personal Information you submit through a Third-Party Integration or recruiter will be subject to the privacy practices of those entities. If you are a current Rayleigh employee, please contact our Privacy Officer per Section 11 below for more information on how your employee information may be collected, stored, used, and distributed.

#### 4. **Personal Information We Collect When You Use the Services or Website.**

- a. **Cookies.** When you use the Services or Website, Rayleigh may collect certain information through technologies such as cookies and other automatic data collection technologies ("**Cookies**"). We may use Cookies for authentication and to compile aggregate statistics about usage of the Website, such as how long users spend using the Website and what parts or pages of the Website are viewed most often. This information is used to improve the content and operation of the Website. We may also use Cookies to promote the Website or our Services through marketing and advertising. These Cookies may be accessed or disclosed to third parties for the purpose of serving you relevant advertisements. You may opt out of Cookies or prevent third-party websites from accessing our Cookies by adjusting your privacy settings on your browser. However, opting out of Cookies may disable some features of the Website and may prevent us from providing you with the information and services you have requested.
- b. **Device and Location Information.** When you use the Website, Rayleigh may collect information about your device ("**Device Information**"). Some Device Information, such as unique device identifiers, may constitute Personal Information. The Personal Information we collect from Device Information can depend on the individual settings of your device or browser that you use to access the Website. We recommend checking the policies of your device manufacturer or the browser's provider to learn what Device Information may be shared with Rayleigh. You may disable the sharing of Device Information, but doing so may disable some features of the Website and

may prevent us from providing you with the information and services you have requested.

- 5. How We Use Information We Collect.** We use Personal Information in the following ways:
- a. To authenticate and onboard you, and provide you access to the Website and facilitate provision of Services;
  - b. To provide, maintain, improve, and enhance the Services and Website;
  - c. To develop new Rayleigh products, features, and services;
  - d. To communicate with you, provide you with updates and other information relating to the Services and Website, provide information that you request, respond to comments and questions, and otherwise provide customer support;
  - e. For marketing and advertising purposes, such as developing and providing promotional and advertising materials that may be relevant, valuable, or otherwise of interest to you, where you have subscribed to receive them;
  - f. To find and prevent fraud, and respond to trust and safety issues that may arise;
  - g. For compliance purposes, as may be required by applicable laws and regulations or requested by any judicial process or governmental agency; and
  - h. For other purposes for which we obtain your consent at the time the Personal Information is collected.
- 6. Who We Share Your Information With.** We may share your Personal Information with our employees and with third parties, such as selected business partners, suppliers, or sub-contractors, while performing our contractual obligations. These third parties may include web hosting partners and our IT service providers.

We have put in place contractual and other organizational safeguards with such third parties to protect your Personal Information from unauthorized uses and disclosures. Such third parties have limited access to Personal Information solely for the purposes described herein, and they will be subject to contractual restrictions prohibiting them from using such Personal Information for any other purpose.

In addition, we may disclose your Personal Information to third parties:

- a. In connection with a corporate re-organization, a merger or amalgamation with another entity, or a sale of all or a substantial portion of our assets or shares, including any due diligence exercise carried out in relation to the same, provided that the Personal Information disclosed continues to be used for the purposes permitted by this Privacy Policy by the entity acquiring the Personal Information;
- b. If we have reason to believe that disclosing this Personal Information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property, other

users of the Website or recipients of the Services, or anyone else (including the rights or property of anyone else) that could be harmed by such activities; or

- c. If we believe in good faith that such disclosure is required by and in accordance with the law.

Our servers and those of third parties who may receive your Personal Information may be located outside of Canada and/or the U.S. Accordingly, your Personal Information may be available to foreign governments or their agencies under a lawful order, irrespective of the safeguards we have put in place for the protection of your Personal Information.

7. **Data Retention and Deletion.** We will keep your Personal Information for as long as it remains necessary for the identified purpose or as required by law, which may extend beyond the termination of our relationship with you. All retained Personal Information will remain subject to the terms of this Privacy Policy. You have the right to ask us to remove your Personal Information from our databases, and we will do so to the best of our ability, but it may not be possible to completely delete all of your Personal Information due to technological and legal constraints (for example, when your Personal Information pertains to other users of the Website or recipients of the Services).
8. **Access and Accuracy.** You may access the Personal Information we hold about you to verify accuracy of your Personal Information, to have a general account of our uses of your Personal Information, and to correct your Personal Information as appropriate. Upon receipt of your written request, we will provide you with a copy of your Personal Information although in certain limited circumstances, we may not be able to make all relevant Personal Information available to you (for example, where that Personal Information also pertains to another user of the Website or recipients of the Services). In such circumstances, we will provide reasons for the denial to you upon request. We will make every reasonable effort to keep your Personal Information accurate, and to respond to you in a timely manner.
9. **Security.** We use commercially reasonable efforts to store and maintain your Personal Information in a secure environment. We take technical, contractual, administrative, and physical security steps designed to protect Personal Information that you provide to us. We have implemented procedures designed to limit the dissemination of your Personal Information to only such designated staff and third parties as reasonably necessary to carry out the stated purposes we have communicated to you.
